
New or Improved

Additional Scales

Based on feedback from PlanSwift users, we've added several Scales:


6" = 1'0"	1:5

You'll see these new Scales in the different Scale drop-downs:




Invoking the drop-down from the toolbar





Clicking the Scale button and then clicking on the Auto tab




When adding a New Blank Page to the project



Updated "Show me how" Videos


We've updated these videos, more are planned:

Changes

We removed the option "Single Click Subtract Section" from the area takeoff object context menu that was never implemented. Because this functionality was never completed, trying to use it caused a program error and the safest solution, for the time being, is to simply remove the option from the menu.



Known Issues

- After importing a Job using PlanSwift Connect, if it is the last opened job, the job does not automatically open on screen after restarting PlanSwift.
 - Workaround: Users can open the Job manually. (Will be fixed in future release)
- Deleted Pages Recycle Bin Folder is not clearing itself periodically. Deleted Pages are stored in a folder called Recycle Bin that should clear periodically to free up space on the user's hard drive.
 - Workaround: Users can clear/empty the Recycle Bin manually. (Will be fixed in future release)
